
**Survey Results - FINAL TOPLINE**

The Idaho Republican Primary Survey was conducted by IVR and Online Interviews from April 9 -12 among a random sample of 549 likely voters. The survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.2 percentage points. Results are weighted. Some percentages in crosstab reports for this poll may not add to 100% due to rounding.


































